This program is designed for the following types of events; closed course watercraft racing. This certificate is not valid for organizations not members of International Jet Sport Boating Association (IJSBA)
2. Contingency will be paid for only the listed events and sanctioning bodies (affiliate members of IJSBA) as indicated. All claims must be signed by an event or sanctioning body official, if not, payment will not be made. Racers have the responsibility to have the claim properly completed (providing all requested information) and mail to the address above. Please allow 4-6 weeks for processing of checks after the June 24, 2001, September 16, 2001, and October 14, 2001.
3. For the 2001 race season, all claims must be sent in by the racer, within 10 days of the event, and postmarked no later than July 5, 2001 (for races taking place between March 24, 2001-June 24, 2001) September 26, 2001 (for races taking place between June 25, 2001 – September 16, 2001) and October 28, 2001 (for the Skat-Trak World Finals). Claims postmarked after these dates will not be honored. At some events, there is a possibility that a Bombardier representative will present publicly an enlarged check only for photography. .
4. To qualify for the 2001 Sea-Doo Challenge program above noted Sea-Doo watercraft must have Sea-Doo Logo decals on both sides of watercraft. Sea-Doo logo decals must be a minimum of Two (2”) inch tall lettering.
5. Bombardier Recreational Products reserves the right to reject a claim not properly or fraudulently filed and reserves the right to cancel this program at any time.
